Greetings Prom Attendees and Parents,

May 16, 2022

The REACH! Partnership Senior/Junior Prom will take place on May 27, 2022 from 7pm – 11pm at REACH! Below are a few procedures and guidelines we expect all prom goers to abide by.

- Doors to the Prom will close promptly at 8:30pm. Students and/or their invited guests will not be permitted after the doors have closed. No tickets will be sold at the door.
- All students and their guests are subject to our daily intake process (metal detectors and wands). Students refusing to enter through a screening forfeit their evening and will not be allowed entry.
- There is a no re-entry policy. If a student(s) choose to leave, they will not be permitted back in to the prom.
- Parents may not enter the building. Parents are welcome to take final pictures at the drop-off location.
- Lifetouch Studios will be present to take formal prom pictures for a cost. We will also have a 360 Camera in the building as well.

If students are being driven to the prom, please enter the parking lot closest to 25th Street (BP Gas Station) and travel down the parking continuing behind the gym and pull all the way up to the Main Office Entrance where students may be dropped off. If students are driving and are parking, they may use the back-parking lot behind the gym and walk the ramp to the main office entrance.

- REACH! Partnership adheres to the Baltimore City School Code of Conduct and will confiscate any item we see poses a danger to the safety of the evening. These items include but are not limited to:
 - Weapons (guns, knives, lighters, mace) of any kind that can be used in an aggressive and malicious manner towards another guest
 - Mace, Pepper Spray, Vape Pens, lighters and any other incendiary (fire starting device). This also includes tobacco and any marijuana items
 - Disruptive behavior (disrespect, insubordination and/or fighting) will result in immediate removal from the event.

All students must also make sure that their dress is appropriate to wear in a formal setting. The senior class advisors and school counselors reviewed back in March what is acceptable and not but here is a quick review:

- No dress or outfit that reveals a deep plunging neck line
- No outfit that has slits going all the way up
- No see-through material in areas that reveal an individual's private
- No sweat suits or sweat pants are allowed

Any student who is in need of attire may schedule an appointment to see Ms. McKinney for a visit to her Prom attire and accessories.
